One girl's story

Orphaned and alone at age 12, Chanty* was thrilled when a foreign man asked her to go for a boat ride to an island. "It never entered my mind that he would do anything bad to me," she said. "He forced me, and he hit me." Terrified and ashamed, she was grateful when a woman offered her a job in a restaurant.

But it was a trap. She had been sold into prostitution. "They told me they [would] kill me if I tried to leave."


Amazingly, Chanty did escape, and the police brought her to the World Vision Trauma Recovery Center, where she learned life skills, got counseling and loving support.



No coat for a child in one of Asia's coldest places

When she was 6 years old, Soyolmaa's home burned down, and she had to move into a cold, run-down former military barracks. In Mongolia where she lives, the temperature can drop to minus 50 degrees Fahrenheit. Without a coat of her own, Soyolmaa became imprisoned by the ice and wind outside. And, although her father works hard to provide for their family of seven, he barely makes enough for food. There are no coats for the children.

The World Vision Difference

Soyolmaa remembers trying to play in the snow with no winter coat. Soon she was in real danger. "I froze. I tried to run to keep warm." She quickly ran back into the abandoned barracks she calls home.

Frostbite and hypothermia not only pose the threat of permanent damage or even death, they also mean children like Soyolmaa are forced to drop out of school, giving up on their dreams of a better life.





Contaminated water infects and kills children

Around the world, about one in six people has no access to safe water. According to UNICEF, over 1,800 childhood deaths a day are connected to dirty water and lack of sanitation. Through World Vision, you have a variety of ways to stop children's suffering by fighting these waterborne diseases.



CHOLERA is a severe bacterial infection that causes children to have extreme diarrhea and vomiting. Transmitted through contaminated drinking water, it can lead to death.



GIARDIA is a highly contagious parasite that causes severe diarrhea and dehydration, and can kill babies and toddlers.



TYPHOID attacks a child with heavy sweating, diarrhea, and sustained high fever that can lead to delirium and cause death.

Lift a child out of suffering Alphonsine, at age 8, had typhoid and malaria. She was stunted, weak, and incredibly sick. Clean water helps turn lives like hers around.

The hand-drilled well from Water4 also includes an inventive water pump made of lightweight and affordable PVC, using natural compression instead of suction. So it lasts longer—and is easy enough for a child to operate.
